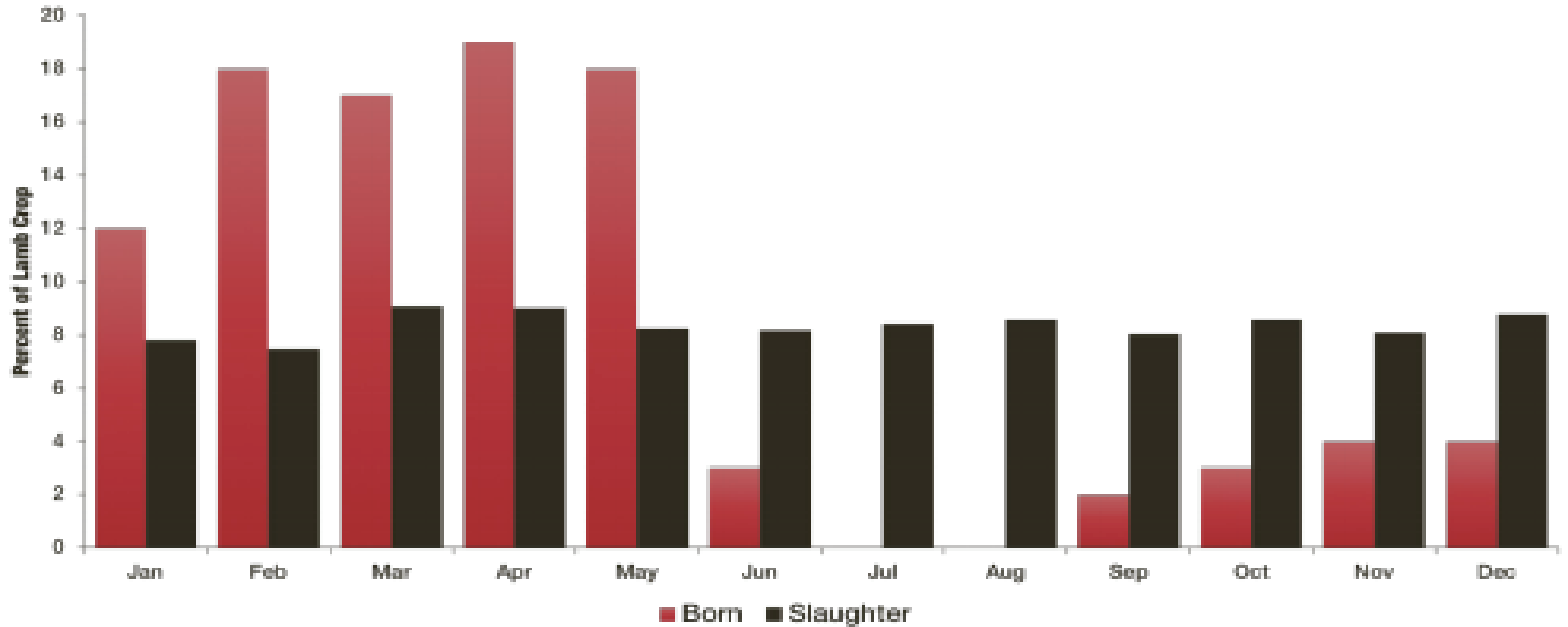

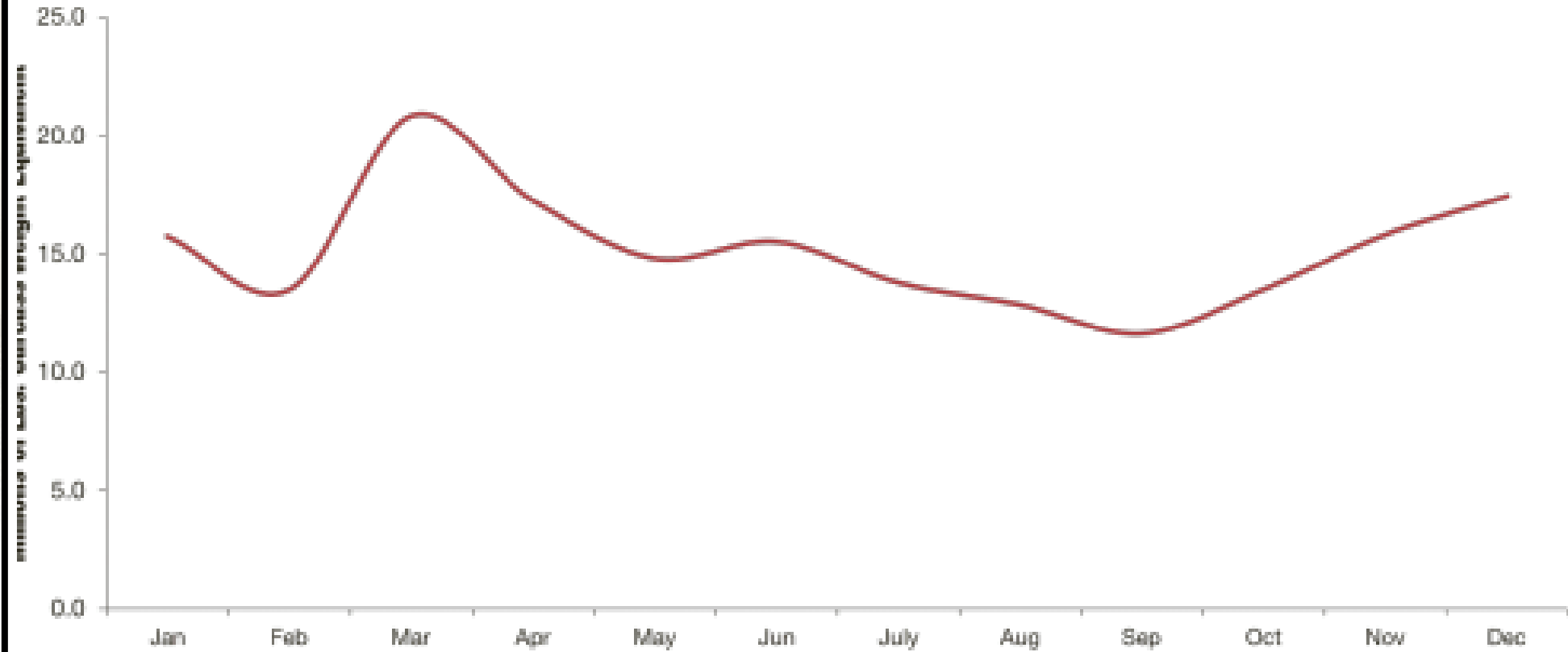
Birth and Harvest for US Lambs

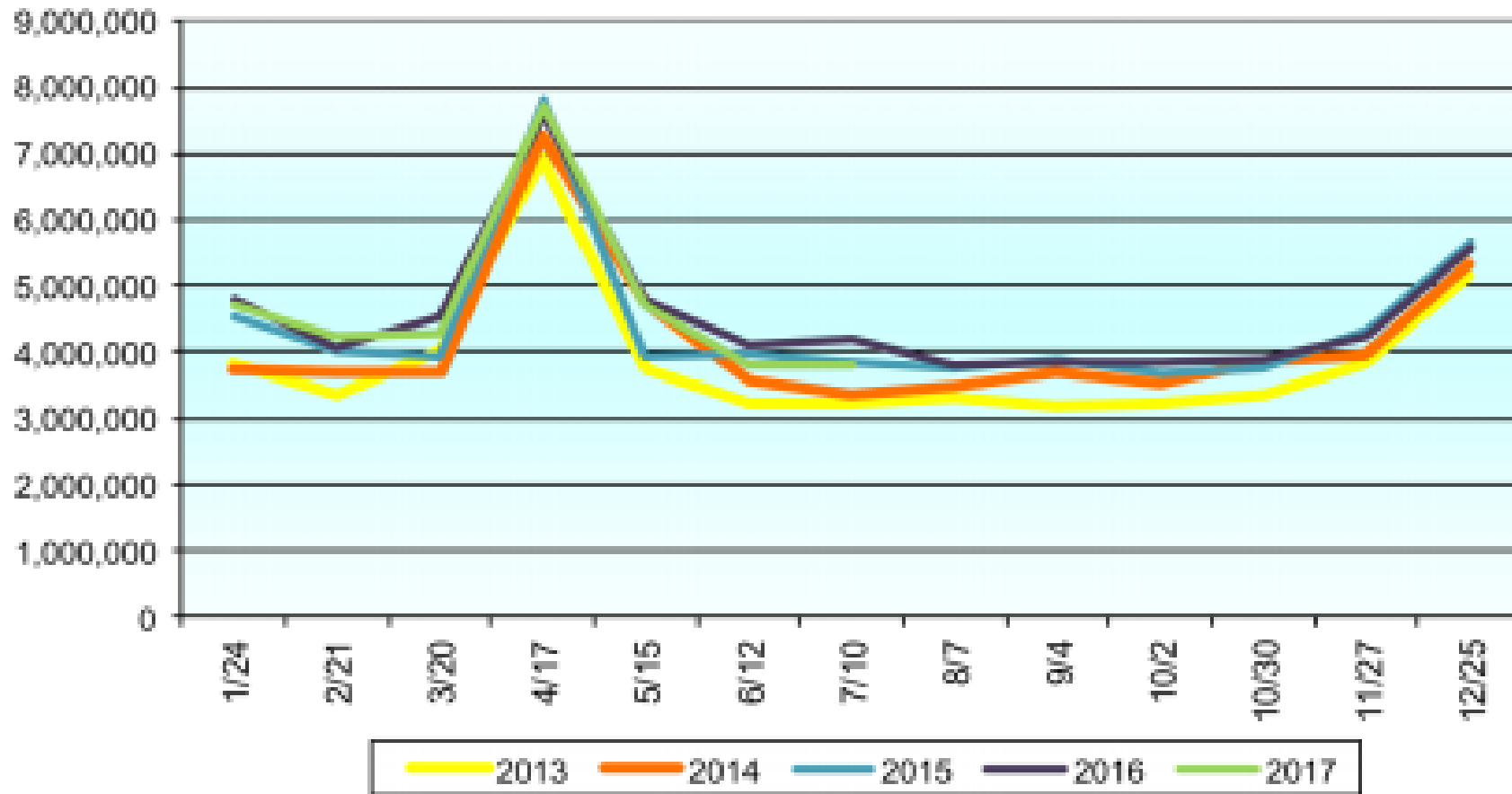
Monthly Average of Imported Lamb 2010 to 2016

Total Lamb Pounds

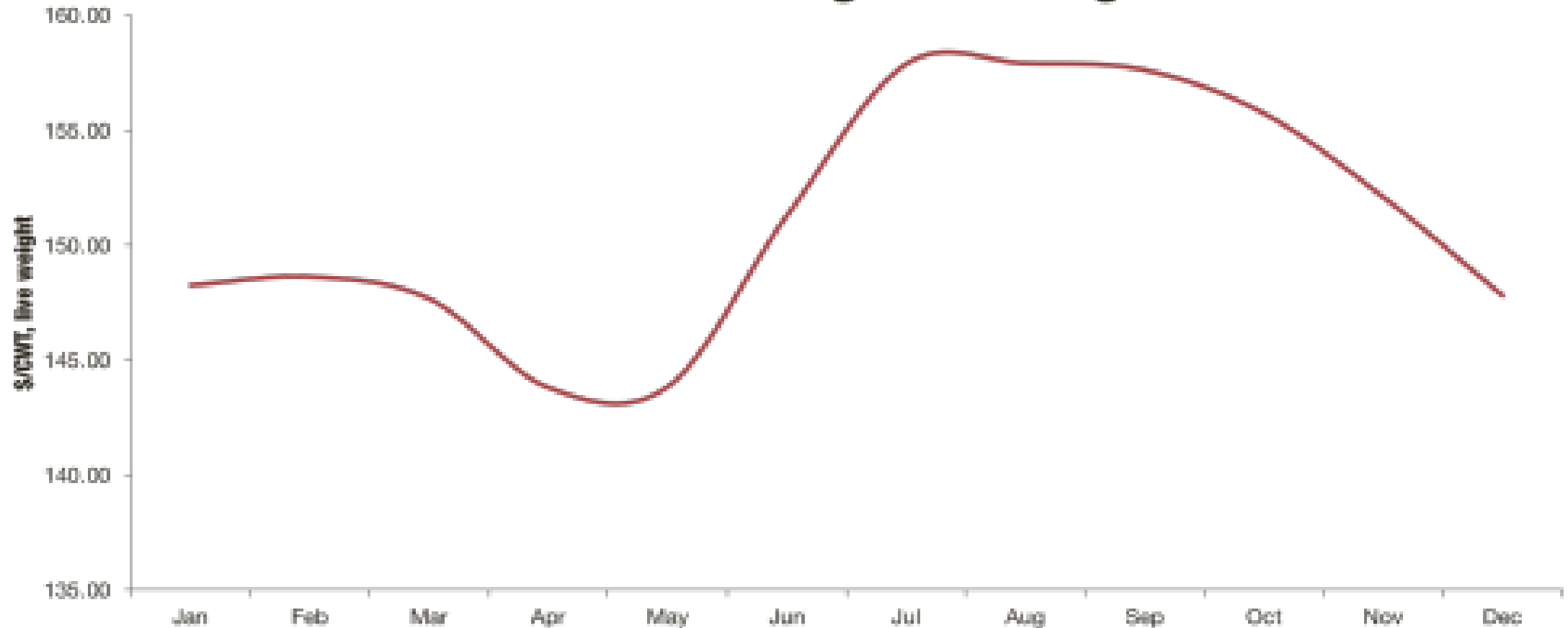
